**Can You Spot Them?**

Are you good at hide and seek? Some animals which live in the wild are very good at camouflage. You can see them in the air, on land, and in the sea. Their special looks or abilities keep them safe from predators. Let me guide you through the world of animal camouflage.

**Mountain Hare**

Mountain hares are like rabbits, but they are bigger and have longer legs. They are very stylish animals. Mountain hares change colors according to season. In summer, they turn gray-brown to match the rocks and grass. In winter, they turn white to camouflage themselves in the snow. Changing colors makes them nearly invisible to predators like wild dogs and eagles.

**Did you know?**

Mountain hares have really big feet. Thanks to them, mountain hares can hop in deep snow and escape from predators.

**Octopus**

Look closely at a rock under the sea. If it moves, it might be an octopus. Octopuses are sea animals with rounded bodies and eight long arms. When octopuses feel danger, they use their special camouflage skill. Octopuses can change colors and patterns to match their surroundings. If they're near sea plants, they look like sea plants. If they're near coral reefs, they look like coral reefs. They can also stick shells on their bodies to look like a rock. This can fool predators completely.

**Did you know?**

Octopuses can spread ink. It creates a dark cloud that blocks the view of predators. This gives them enough time to escape.

## **Owl**

In many cultures, owls are known as wise and smart birds. They certainly use their camouflage in a wise way. The special feathers of owls protect them from predators. The colors and patterns of their feathers match their natural environment. So, when they sit in a tree, they look just like part of the tree. They become almost invisible to other animals. This gives them a huge advantage in the wild!

### **Did you know?**

Owls have the amazing ability to turn their heads almost all the way around. They can scan their surroundings by only moving their heads. This helps them to spot danger or food quickly.
